Since April 18th, 2024, Château Rauzan-Gassies is being part of the Living Heritage Companies of France (EPV). This tremendous recognition represents the values of responsible economic development, the *art de vivre* and the influence of France. The château relied on three of its assets to obtain this label:

- A 100% family commitment: beyond fashion, for nearly 90 years and three generations, our family has included Château Rauzan-Gassies in the restricted universe of Family Grands Crus Classés of Bordeaux. This transmission drives our passion for our profession, both guaranteeing our values and our ambitions for the future.

- A centuries-old vineyard : planted in the heart of Margaux since the 17th century and established from the Château Second Grand Cru classification in 1855, its 30 hectares are surrounded by as many forests and meadows classified as a Natura 2000 zone, a true reserve of local biodiversity. It constitutes the Living Heritage of the Château, which we take care of, day after day, with passion and patience.

- The influence of its international distribution: over time, prescribers in France and abroad, recognizing the consistency of the château, have shown their confidence in us. Thus, connoisseurs from all continents appreciate the wines of Château Rauzan-Gassies, vintage after vintage.
